"And I believe it has a new zero recidivism rate among the graduates," Jones said.

The judge said there is still work to be done, though.

He noted the judicial branch often gets overlooked and reminded county commissioners about the importance of the court system.

"The counties of the district should supplement the salary of the district judge by at least \$5,000-\$10,000," he said. "And the counties must increase funding for the prosecution — including an increase in attorney compensation, adding positions for certified paralegals and increasing investigative staff."

With almost two years left on the bench, Jones said he plans on serving as the "caretaker" of the court and not yield to political or public opinions or pressure.


